Parents and guardians are welcome to observe the audition process and must sign acceptance of scholarship documents for students under 18 years old.

What to Expect at the Audition

Our audition is designed to be welcoming, supportive, and beginner-friendly. Students will be evaluated on key qualities that reflect both artistic potential and personal discipline.

The audition includes:

- **Basic Technique Review:** posture, footwork, rhythm, and coordination
- **Learning a Short Choreography Sequence:** taught during the audition
- **Stage Presence Assessment:** confidence, energy, and ability to follow direction
- **Cultural Interest:** brief conversation about why the student wants to join folklórico
- **Commitment & Reliability:** evaluation of readiness to participate in rehearsals and performances

What to Wear & Bring

To ensure safety and comfort, we recommend the following:

Wear:

- Comfortable workout or dance clothing

No student is judged solely on experience. We recognize talent, dedication, and heart in many forms.

- Closed-toe shoes or dance shoes if available
- Hair tied back and secured



Bring:

- Water bottle
- Small towel (optional)
- Parent/guardian contact information
- Any accommodations the student may need

Who Can Audition?

Students must be:

- Currently enrolled in **MISD, PSJA, MCISD, Sharyland ISD, or ECISD**
- High school age (9th–12th grade)
- Able to attend regular practices and performances if selected
- Committed to maintaining academic responsibility

No experience is required. Students of all skill levels are welcome.

 - Regional folkloric styles
 - Cultural and historical context
